Items We CAN Take: By Category

PLEASE clean items before arriving. (No food or dirt inside; drain liquids)

<p>#1 'See-Through' Plastic Bottles & Jars with screw-on top loosened</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Water, soft drink, juice, peanut butter, cooking oil, etc. 	<p>'Mixed' Paper</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dark or bright paper, phone books, cereal boxes, manila envelopes, file folders, etc.
<p>#2 Cloudy Plastic Jugs & Bottles w/ Bottom Seam</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Milk, vinegar, cat litter, sunnyD, windshield washing solution, etc. 	<p>Office Paper</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Mostly white or pastel paper including envelopes
<p>#2 Colored Plastic Jugs & Bottles (usually w/ screw-on top)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Bleach, detergent, shampoo, coffee, etc. 	<p>Magazines & Catalogs</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Slick, shiny pages throughout. NO newspaper inserts
	<p>Newspapers w/ inserts</p>
<p>#5 Plastic Containers</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Tubs - sour cream, cottage cheese, CoolWhip, etc. Other - Orange/bl/gr prescription bottles, QT cups, anything w/ #5 NO clear clam shell containers 	<p>Shredded Paper</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Must be shredded before arrival
	<p>Cardboard</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Heavy corrugated boxes and brown paper bags
<p>Stretchable Plastic Bags</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Grocery, zip-lock, bread, newspaper, dry-cleaning bags; bubble wrap, 6-pack carriers 	<p>Books</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hardback and paperback for library or for recycling
<p>Tin/Steel Cans and Lids</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cat food cans included 	<p>Glass Bottles & Jars</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> All colors of clean bottles, food jars, casserole lids, coffee carafes, window & shelf glass, picture frame glass, vases (not white), etc.
<p>Aluminum Beverage Cans</p>	
<p>Scrap Metal (dumpster in back)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Metal only. Get approval from manager for appliances. NO wire products (fencing, clothes hangers, sign supports, etc.) 	<p>Other</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Print and toner cartridges, cell phones, rechargeable batteries, eyeglasses, DVDs

Items We CANNOT Take

NO items that are dirty or have food in them

NO Styrofoam or styrene

- Packing material, cups, trays, insulated coolers, clamshell carryout containers, etc.

NO PVC, ABS, Nylon, Vinyl

- Pipe, siding, electronic cases, woven/net bags, blinds, hoses, floor protectors/runners, shower curtains, etc.

NO Hazardous Waste

- Oil, antifreeze, paint, insecticides, CFL bulbs, etc.

NO Other

- Clear clam shell containers, chip/snack bags, vinyl bags, very dark plastic bottles, Solo cups, plant pots, infant car seats, plastic play sets, hose reels, 3-ring notebooks, light bulbs, VHS tapes, plastic signs, plastic buckets w/wire handles, self-adhesive labels, aluminum foil, disposable pie pans, alkaline batteries, etc.

You CANNOT drop off bags of unsorted materials and leave.

Also, we can't guarantee the security of anything left at the Center. We do not shred paper. PLEASE check to see if confidential information is in your papers, medicine containers, cell phones, etc. We reserve the right to give away or sell for re-use anything brought to the Center.
